The Grand Lodge of Virginia intends to increase the assessment from \$55 to \$65 starting in 2025. In order to maintain a healthy fund balance at the lodge, we will be increasing our dues from \$205 to \$225 beginning in January 2025. We will be discussing and voting on this increase at our next stated meeting on March 21st. We will also be discussing an annual 2.5% cost-of-living increase to the dues to take effect every year moving forward. If you would like to be part of this discussion, please attend the meeting.
